About Us:

We are a small privately owned and operated RV and Horse Park that lends itself to the old Florida simple country life. We sit on 150 acres just off of **US 129 and 48th Street**, just north of I-10 and just south of Spirit of the Suwannee. We are a quiet, safe place with big shady oaks, where you can set up camp, relax and enjoy yourself and nature.

- We are a private facility and work strictly by appointment for access.
- We are only 2.5 miles to amenities in town: Walmart, restaurants, laundromat, fuel, feed stores, auto services and dealers, salons, tack shops, clothing, liquor stores, and shopping. There are great local veterinarians, farriers, and, of course, ShandsLiveOak Regional Medical Center.
- Due to the convenience of town, our camp amenities and our fees can be kept to a minimum. We focus on comfort and safety.
- We have 18 new full-service drive-through RV hookups and additional full-service sites by pond- and creek-side (which are not drive through).
- There are handicap-accessible bathrooms and showers, as well as a quaint, newly-refurbished silo bathroom/shower.
- For the horse lovers, we have six 1-acre paddocks with run-in sheds and horse wire with electric fencing. Of course, each site has access to clean water and can accommodate 4 or more horses for those traveling with friends. There are also two 80x20 paddocks, eight 25x25, and four 25x50 individual paddocks, each with run-in sheds and fresh water. We can accommodate boarding on an individual basis.
- We have a one acre dog park and dog kennels for those campers that need a safe place to put the pooch while dining out or off premise commitments. (We do love our animals here!)
- You can relax by a fire pit, enjoy the BBQs/picnic tables, or the Gazebo & Hammock by the pond. You can fish or watch the deer, enjoy our bird houses and the nightly owls and wildlife. Nature and horse lovers can enjoy the miles of trails at the neighboring Mattair Springs or the Suwannee River Linville tract.

There is ample opportunity to create great memories with good friends. We are a small, intimate park that cares about our guests, their animals, and the environment. We look forward to sharing this piece of old Florida with you and yours.
